13h – 15h of June 2014 Studsgård, Denmark

Welcome to the complete ETC warm up tournament package. Here you will get all your questions answered and hopefully be left with a strong enthusiastic will to participate.

The tournament address:

Studsgård Minihal Momhøjvej 36A 7400 Herning Denmark

Rules and restrictions:

The tournament will commence exactly like the real ETC tournament. You can learn all about it here: http://warhammer.org.uk/index.html Only difference being the timetable for the tournament.

Signing up:

You can sign up for the tournament by writing an e-mail to <u>etcwarmup@nifcon.dk</u> there are 14 team spots up for grabs.

When you sign up You will be asked to transfer the entry fee for the tournament – you have 14 days to get this done. Otherwise your spot at the tournament is lost, and you have to sign up again. We will NOT be supplying stand inn players!

The 14th spot:

Different factors can cause situations where we are left with an uneven number of teams. As an insurance the 14^{th} spot is free! At any time you can choose to sign your team up as the 14^{th} team – thus participating for free. Off cause only one team can do this.

If the situation arises where we end up with an uneven number of teams the 14th team will be converted into an 8 man singles tournament.

When signing up the 14th team will be asked to pay the entry fee just as any other team but will get the full entry fee back when arriving at the tournament.

Entry fee:

275€

We do not refund money if for some reason you have to cancel your participation. So do NOT sign up unless you are perfectly sure that you will be attending the tournament, and you are able to field an 8 man team!

Accommodation:

The tournament takes place next to a public school. There will be class rooms available to sleep in. You just bring sleeping bags etc. Alternatively you can camp outside if you bring a tent.

This is included in the tournament fee.

Food:

The entry fee includes a basic breakfast.

Alcohol:

You can enjoy moderate amounts of alcohol at the tournament. We do not want to see drunk people or experience drunken behavior. If this happens you will be asked to leave the tournament. Not kidding! The outer doors at the gaming hall closes 30 minutes after the last game – this is important if you are planning on going out for a drink at night.

We strongly emphasize that this is a competitive tabletop tournament – if you chose to participate it should be because you want to play competitive warhammer and not because you want to get drunk!

Extra people:

The entry fee includes the possibility for each team to bring up to two extra persons. Coaches, Stand inns, Cheerleaders etc.

Open army lists:

Instead of posting your army lists on a public forum you have to email them to etcwarmup@nifcon.dk no later than 20th of May. Collect all your army lists in ONE SINGLE PDF file before emailing! Please respect this deadline. Failing to abide to this deadline results in a penalty of up to 100 tournament points.

Terrain:

The terrain will be standard tournament terrain. We will not be using the ETC terrain maps. Teams can bring terrain and make a set of tables to the correct ETC map standards – if this happens the team will play all of its games on these or similar tables. Please let us know if your team chooses this option!
